<b>COUN 263 AIDS Awareness</b>	<b>1 Credit hour</b>	
Course designed to increase awareness of Human Immunodeficiency Virus and Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome, including: the virus, psychosocial aspects, legal and religious issues, prevention, treatment.		
<b>Grade Mode:</b> Normal Grading Mode		
<b>COUN 264 Group Guid Resident Setting I</b>	<b>1 Credit hour</b>	
A Counselor Leadership training course focusing on basic peer helper and leadership skills. Specific areas include an overview of theory and concerns for college students living in residence halls. (PR: Permission)

<b>COUN 425 Counseling Theory &amp; Tech</b>	<b>3 Credit hours</b>	
Principles and practices of the interviewing relationship in helping service settings.		
<b>Pre-req:</b> (CR 306 or COUN 306) and (CR 370 or COUN 370).		
<b>Co-req:</b> COUN 470		
<b>Grade Mode:</b> Normal Grading Mode		
<b>COUN 430 Case Devel Process/Manage</b>	<b>3 Credit hours</b>	
Study of systematic development of casework to include case finding, follow-up provision of services, case recording and time management.		
<b>Pre-req:</b> (CR 306 or COUN 306) and (CR 370 or COUN 370).		
<b>Grade Mode:</b> Normal Grading Mode		
<b>COUN 455 Crisis Inter &amp; Conf Res</b>	<b>3 Credit hours</b>	
This course is directed to anyone who at some time has felt inadequate in responding effectively to people in crisis. Topics will include situational and developmental crisis.

<b>COUN 456 Death &amp; Grief Coun</b>	<b>3 Credit hours</b>	
Includes three areas of emphasis: To enable the student to come to grips with personal attitudes toward death and dying; to explore attitudes of society toward death; and to develop skills in managing the crisis of death terminal illness and bereavement.

Practical experiences in counseling interviews under professional supervision.		
<b>Pre-req:</b> (CR 306 or COUN 306) and (CR 370 or COUN 370).		
<b>Co-req:</b> COUN 425

<b>COUN 476 Counseling with Parents</b>	<b>3 Credit hours</b>	
Consideration of effective parent counseling primarily from an Adlerian point of view. Techniques for counselor intervention via lecture demonstration and laboratory experiences.		
<b>Pre-req:</b> (CR 370 or COUN 370) and (CR 306 or COUN 306).		
<b>Grade Mode:</b> Normal Grading Mode		
<b>COUN 477 Stress Management Couns</b>	<b>3 Credit hours</b>	
Provides beginning counselors and others with comprehensive information and strategies for successful management of stress and its consequences. Students explore theoretical and practical alternatives in counseling the stressed individual.
